As we share the information on how the COVID-19 virus has impacted our facilities, please know that the clinical and administrative teams across our organization are working tirelessly to manage this crisis.

We are taking steps based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Department of Public Health and the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to reduce the spread and impact of COVID-19, such as:

- Enhanced infection control precautions including PPE coaches and education, frequent cleaning with specialized cleaning agents, and environmental controls
- Screening residents, staff, and essential visitors for symptoms of COVID-19 or recent exposure to COVID-19
- Frequent testing of staff and residents for COVID-19 based on current protocols
- Facility-specific mitigating actions will be provided via telephone or email communications
